How long does it take?

KITA-ONLINE is open right now for all new registrations. Registrations should be submitted no later than 15 December in the year preceding the year in which you wish your child to be admitted into a kindergarten. Children will generally be admitted into the kindergarten on 1 August each year.

The kindergarten management bodies (the institutions responsible for the kindergartens) are only able to decide upon admissions once the Youth Services Committee has taken a decision on the kindergarten places. This is expected to occur during February in the year of admission. You will then be notified accordingly by the kindergarten management about which kindergarten has a place available for you.



What is Kita-Online?

You have internet access?

Important!

KITA-ONLINE is an online system for registering your need for a childcare place at one of Kamp-Lintfort's day-care facilities/family centres. KITA-ONLINE is used to coordinate new admissions into KITAs (kindergartens) on 1 August each year.

In 2014, the State of North-Rhein Westphalia decreed in the 2nd Amending Act to the Child Education Act that the desire for a childcare place must be registered in writing with the Youth Welfare Office (Jugendamt) at least six months before taking up a kindergarten place. KITA-ONLINE is being used to implement this Act. If you have already familiarised yourself with your preferred kindergartens, you can easily register your child for a kindergarten place from the comfort of your home via:

www.kamp-lintfort.de/kita-online

Select your preferred kindergarten and fill out the details about yourself and your child. The programme will guide you through the registration process.

Please note: Once you have filled out all the details and submitted your child's registration, you will receive a confirmation email. In order to complete the registration process – and ensure that your child is logged in the system – you must click on the link in the confirmation email.

You don't have any internet access?

No problem! Just speak with the kindergarten management. They can get your child entered into the system at the kindergarten itself or get in touch with Ms Haever from the Office for Schools, Youth Welfare and Sport (her contact details can be found on the last page).

Your child can only receive a kindergarten place if he or she is registered in the KITA-ONLINE system.

An online process is no substitute for face-to-face contact. Visit the kindergartens which appeal to you with your child and introduce yourselves in person. Once you have gained an overview, you can calmly make a decision at home about the kindergartens which you feel are the right choices for you and your child.
